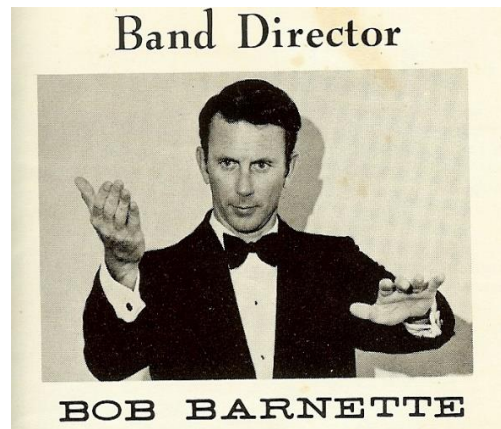


# Bob Barnette Memorial Music Scholarship



Bob Barnette began playing trumpet in elementary school, ultimately playing the acoustic and electric bass, tuba, trumpet and flugel horn. After graduation from Lanier High School of Macon in 1957 he attended the University of Georgia on a full double-bass and trumpet scholarship. After graduation, he spent 30 years in music education. Mr. Barnette was the Band Director at Central High School and conducted the highly-acclaimed Sugar Bear Band. His career was exemplary, with both the Mayor's Office and County Commissioners issuing proclamations in his honor at his retirement in 1994.

Bob believed strongly that he was blessed to have the career of his dreams and his dream was to help others find a love for music and performance. Toward that goal, at his passing on April 14, 2016, his family established the Bob Barnette Memorial Music Scholarship in loving memory.

To be eligible for the award a student must be enrolled in a public or private school, or a verifiable home school. The application must be submitted by a faculty member of the school attended. The following are standards the award committee will review, the student must:

- Be a resident of Bibb, Jones, Monroe or Houston County, Georgia
- Must be of age for middle or high school
- Have a passing grade point average
  - Be actively involved in a music program or desire to be
  - Have a recommendation letter from an appropriate faculty member
  - Present a letter of request and proposed use for funds in his/her own words

Funds are available for the purchasing of musical instruments, music equipment, for private lessons or for in-depth study such as summer music camps.
